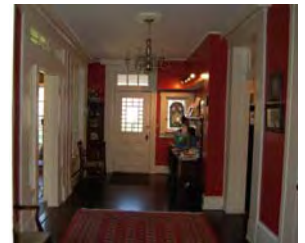

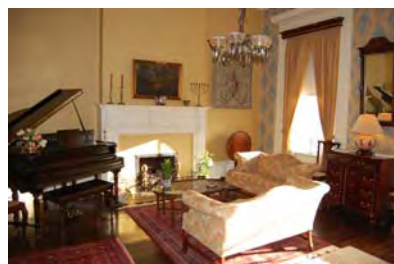

**Columbus Metropolitan Library Honored...**The Columbus Metropolitan Library has been chosen as Library of the Year by *Library Journal*. "The culture of [the library] has become one of perpetual strategic planning, adaptability, constant investment in efficiency and attention to chosen priorities," wrote *Library Journal's* editor at large, John N. Berry III. The award is given each year to one library that demonstrates community service, creativity and innovation in programs that can be emulated by others. The library received \$10,000 at a June 27 ceremony in Washington, D.C. *The Columbus Dispatch, Dean Narciso*

**Fourth of July...**The New Albany Community Events board has planned its annual Fourth of July celebration on Saturday, July 3. The celebration will begin with a parade at 11 am, starting at New Albany Middle School and looping down Route 62 to Market Street and back to Dublin-Granville Road. The parade will end at the middle school. The festival will begin at 4 pm, instead of 6 pm like in previous years. It will be held at the New Albany High School Commons off Fodor Road. The celebration will wrap up with a 25-minute fireworks display that will start at dark. The fireworks will be at the New Albany football stadium, which will be open for viewing. *ThisWeek News, Gail Martineau, P. A2, 3 June 2010*

**Special Activities for Residents Highlight BIA Parade of Homes...**New this year for parents is *Kids Village*, a child area open daily from 12 pm until 6 pm and complete with an arts area, mobile game trailer (Xbox, Wii, and Play Station enabled), movie tent and special toddler play area. *Kid Village* is open to children ages 2—16 and is \$10 for an unlimited stay. Parade admission is still free for any child, ages 12 and under, with a paid accompanying parent.

**Third Street Renovations...**Drivers who frequent Third Street of New Albany could see improvements in their daily commute by the end of the year. New Albany Village Council unanimously approved a resolution to plan for a major overhaul of the road, spearheaded by engineering design firm EMH&T. The contract's cost is not to exceed \$45,000. The resolution is the first step in the project. It authorizes the village to enter into a contract to have the road studied and a new design conceptualized. The preliminary study will include surveying and preparation of construction plans for all of Third Street, from state Route 62 to South Dublin-Granville Road. The project would add curbs and gutters to the street. It would also see new sidewalks installed on the street's east and west sides, replacing existing overgrown sidewalks. The revamped road will also include on-street parking on its west side. New streetlights will be installed on both sides, and phone lines that currently run alongside the road will be relocated underground. The reconstruction could have environmental benefits as well. A special system of drain pipes will collect rain and feed it to tree lawns along the road, which will greatly improve storm water management. *New Albany News, Brett Nuckles, P. 1-2, 17 June 2010*

# Development News...

**Construction of Roundabout...**Motorists driving near the intersection of Reynoldsburg-New Albany and Morse roads should prepare for a longer commute. Construction on a new roundabout was scheduled to begin Monday, June 14, lasting until the middle of September. Dean Ringle, Franklin County engineer, said the project includes the installation of a one-lane roundabout, a grade adjustment to Morse Road and a slight shift of the intersection to the northwest. The intersection, currently a four way stop, will be entirely closed while workers from the Shelly & Sands contracting firm complete the \$2.4 million Franklin County project. Drivers heading north or south on Reynoldsburg-New Albany Road will be rerouted to Kitzmiller and Dublin-Granville roads. Those heading east or west on Morse Road will be asked to use Babbitt, Dublin-Granville and Johnstown roads.

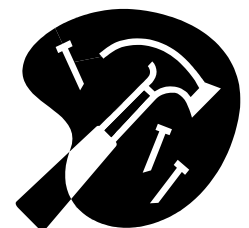
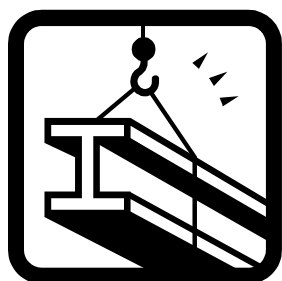
**Metro Parks, Plain Township Still in Talks Over Tract of Land...**Franklin County Metro Parks still is on track to open its Rocky Fork Headwaters park in 2012. John O'Meara, Metro Parks director, met in an executive session with Plain Township trustees and township administrator, Ben Collins, to discuss land acquisition for the proposed 1,200 acre park. They have reached an agreement to sell the township's 32.4 acre lot on Walnut Street. Collins said the township's lot would be a great addition to Rocky Fork Headwaters Metro Park because it would provide an entry to the park. He said the traffic on Walnut Street would draw attention to the new park. *ThisWeek News, Gail Martineau, P. A1 & A2, 10 June 2010*

**Nationwide to Build "Green" Data Center...**Nationwide's proposed 125,000-square-foot facility in the research and information district will be the first Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certified data center in the village and will feature a variety of energy-saving technologies. Rob Brown, director of the company's mission critical group that oversees its data centers around the country, states that "We hope to use energy-efficient equipment and use waterside economizers and air-side economizers. That means we would be able to use the cool conditions of this area to help cool the data portion." Brown said the facility is part of Nationwide's consolidation plan. Soon after the new data center is completed, the company plans to consolidate its 28 data centers into two, with one in New Albany and another in a yet-to-be determined location. The Nationwide data center is estimated to generate more than \$470,000 in taxes, with \$300,000 going to the New Albany-Plain Local School District.

**New Albany Setting Aside More Land for Tech Centers...**Developers of the New Albany Business Park want to expand a section of the sprawling campus that is dedicated to technology operations amid growing demand for remote—yet accessible—land to house data centers and related projects. The effort to add 97 acres to the park's Research & Information District comes after developer, New Albany Company Ltd., lured a \$79 million data center for TJX Companies Inc., parent of the TJ Maxx and Marshalls discount stores. The proposed addition would enlarge the district to 725 acres, of which 260 acres are filled or have commitments for development. Fiber-optic lines have served as a technology backbone of what has become a 24,000-acre corporate park. Additional high-speed data lines and the installation of a third electrical substation came in part to accommodate an American Electric Power Company, Inc. network operations center that open in 2008. Jennifer Chrysler, New Albany's director of community development, said that there is the possibility of annexing land up to Walnut Street, which marks the southern boundary of the planned Rocky Fork Headwaters Metro Park, in order to expand this technology-driven development. *Business First, Brian R. **Village to Receive Grants...**The arrival of Nationwide Mutual Insurance and the TJX Companies is already expected to add 70 jobs to the business park and thousands of tax dollar to New Albany and the school district's coffers. Now, the new companies have helped the village receive \$400,000 in grant dollars. Though the two grants technically are separate, Jennifer Chrysler, village community development director, said they would be used for similar and conjoining projects, since the two companies are building on adjacent sites. *ThisWeek News, Gail Martineau, P.
